Gospel: Mark 6:30-34

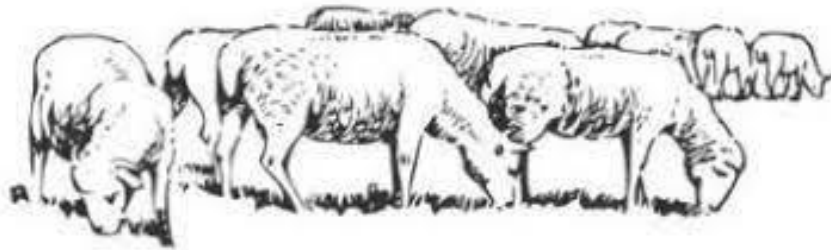
The Lord be with you. **And with your spirit.**


